About made. Creative Space Toowoomba

Founded in February 2011 by artists Alex Stalling and Elysha Rei (nee Gould), made. Creative Space offered up-skilling, public exposure and networking for local artists and acted a voice for the artistic community of Toowoomba. While housed in a multi-roomed gallery above the vibrant restaurant strip of Margaret Street, made. presented many high-quality exhibitions by artists with links to Toowoomba, especially those who went through the school of Creative Arts at the University of Southern Queensland. made. Creative Space retired as an entity in November 2013, with its former site now demolished. Its former Co-Directors are now busy running their own businesses in Toowoomba (www.alexstalling.com) and Thailand (www.elysharei.com and www.samritresidency.com)

Upon reflection

Setting up and running this ARI was an incredible opportunity to grow professionally, creatively and personally. The informal structure with two Co-Directors allowed us the freedom to experiment with ideas and take risks without consequences (aside from chipping in extra for rent that month). The idea started as a one-year project which started just after the floods ravaged through Toowoomba in January 2011. When the doors opened the community embraced a new cultural hub, flocking to the exhibition openings every three weeks and supporting the space through group and solo exhibitions, and curated projects. The artistic and community ties nurtured during the three-year lifespan are still called upon to this day. The skills in event management, exhibition management, and community engagement have all been valuably transferable in many aspects of an arts career since.

Although there were moments of high financial pressure, I'll always look back on these ARI days with fondness, and nostalgic memories of parties, painting walls, innovative problem solving and pure artistic freedom.

Be part of a 12 month project in Toowoomba:

Artists Elysha Gould and Alex Isaacson are taking on an ambitious space promoting a cultural hub in Toowoomba.

The space includes four separate galleries starting from \$240 for a 3 week show, one of which is suitable for experimental, installation and new media works.

The gallery also has one studio space for our resident artist. The studio over looks metropolitan Toowoomba with two large windows, lockable door and access to the galleries private balcony. The resident artist will receive the benefit of their own self-curated exhibition space, for the duration of their lease, featured in the gallery reception. They also receive 24hour access with their own private car park in the heart of Toowoomba CBD. Basic kitchen and amenities are also available.

All exhibiting and resident artists will be promoted by the gallery with street level signage, local media, email newsletters and the gallery website.

The space itself is located in the heart of Toowoomba CBD beside the Tatts Hotel. It has prominent signage visible to both pedestrians and drivers on Margaret Street.

The gallery will be open 3 days a week plus your initial staffed opening night.

Works can be available for sale and there will be no commission taken.

As we said this is set to be a 12 month project so take advantage of this exciting opportunity as it may or may not be around for another year. This is the initial call out for artists before we advertise to the general public so get in quick to secure your spot.

- Opportunities for workshops and artist talks (please specify your interest about public programs on your application form).








